### ACCREDITATION OUTCOME

Clements Primary Academy has met the standard for UNICEF UK's Rights Respecting Schools Award at Silver: Rights Aware.

I am delighted to announce we have been awarded the 'Silver Rights Respecting School Award'

This is in recognition of the work we have been doing on teaching the children about the Unicef Rights of the Child. The assessor was impressed with how the children can articulate their rights and how it helps them to be more considerate of others.

The report states:

Children could talk confidently about a good number of articles and how they are enjoyed in school. They explained that "We get to learn about them and so we know what we're entitled to." They understood that rights are universal "every child in the world has rights" and that "You don't have to earn them."
